19 discovered his passion for working with young people and assisting 20 them in overcoming barriers to success, which led him to pursue a career in social work, and in furtherance of his commitment to 21 22 social services, he served as a case worker for a youth 23 residential group home in Brooklyn, New York, before returning to 24 Mississippi to earn his master of social work degree from Jackson 25 State University in 2021; and 26 WHEREAS, while completing his graduate studies, Mr. Winsett 27 worked as a residential care specialist at a youth residential 28 treatment facility and interned with the Refill Jackson 29 Initiative, where he cultivated a deep appreciation for the 30 organization's mission to equip young adults with workforce skills 31 and social support; and WHEREAS, Mr. Winsett joined the Refill Jackson Initiative 32 33 full-time in May 2021 as a social worker and instructor, and in 34 July 2024, he was elevated to the position of Director of Social Services, where he has been instrumental in advancing the 35 36 organization's programs and initiatives; and 37 WHEREAS, under Mr. Winsett's leadership, RJI has expanded its 38 impact, providing young adults aged 18 to 24 with job training,
