HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 94

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE TWENTY-FIVE COACHES FROM ACROSS
2 MISSISSIPPI WHO HAVE BEEN CHOSEN AS FELLOWS FOR THE 2024-2025
3 CLASS OF TOMORROW'S 25 IN COACHING FELLOWSHIP.

4 WHEREAS, the Tomorrow's 25 Coaching Fellowship is presented
5 by the Mississippi Association of Coaches (MAC); the Mississippi
6 High School Activities Association (MHSAA) and the University of
7 Mississippi's School of Education (UM SOE); and

8 WHEREAS, the Tomorrow's 25 Coaching Fellowship seeks to
9 annually select and invest in 25 future leaders for Mississippi in
10 the area of high school and middle school athletics; and

11 WHEREAS, the following candidates were chosen for the

31 committee, and represent the best the state has to offer based on
32 their competency, character and commitment to their school and
33 community; and

34 WHEREAS, the Tomorrow's 25 Coaching Fellowship seeks to
35 assist in three areas of growth for each candidate: Coaching the
36 Whole Athlete (Leadership, Resilience, Empathy and
37 Responsibility); the opportunity to network with 24 of their peers
38 who have demonstrated the capacity to be our state's future
39 leaders in athletics; and access to current leaders in the
40 Associations (MAC, MHSAA) and college athletics to learn how they
41 can grow their spheres of influence in their communities and
42 across the state; and



43 WHEREAS, the ultimate goal of the Tomorrow's 25 Coaching
44 Fellowship is for the selected candidates to have this time to
45 deliberately work on their craft in a cohort of their peers, so
46 that ultimately their student-athletes and overall communities
47 benefit for years to come; and

48 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
49 recognize and commend the accomplishments of the state's emerging
50 leaders who make exemplary strides in every facet of Mississippi
51 life, particularly those in the educational arena:

53 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby
54 congratulate the selected coaches for the 2024-2025 Tomorrow's 25
