HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 98

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE HINDS
2 COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRACK AND FIELD TEAMS FOR AN OUTSTANDING
3 PERFORMANCE AT THE NATIONAL JUNIOR COLLEGE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION
4 INDOOR NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS, WHERE THEY BROUGHT HOME TWO
5 NATIONAL TITLES, A NEW NJCAA RECORD AND MULTIPLE ALL-AMERICAN
6 HONORS.

7 WHEREAS, the Hinds Community College Track and Field teams
8 delivered an outstanding performance at the National Junior
9 College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Indoor National
10 Championships, bringing home two national titles, a new NJCAA
11 record and multiple All-American honors; and

12 WHEREAS, competing against the best in the nation, both the
13 men's and women's teams showcased their talent and determination,
14 capping off an impressive indoor season; and

15 WHEREAS, Tavon Davis, of Raymond, Mississippi, was named a
16 national champion in the 600 meter run with an incredible time of
17 1:15.61, which not only gave him the win but also broke the NJCAA
18 National Record; and



19 WHEREAS, additionally, Queen Usunobun, of Nigeria, was named
20 a national champion in the 400 meter dash as she raced by her
21 competition with a 53.89 time; and

22 WHEREAS, the women's team secured an impressive 7th-place
23 finish, while the men's team finished 12th overall in the nation,
24 and leading the way were Tavon Davis and Queen Usunobun, who both
25 claimed NJCAA national championships in their respective events;

27 WHEREAS, in addition to the national titles, Hinds had an
28 impressive showing across multiple events, with 17
29 student-athletes earning All-American honors, and their success is
30 a testament to the hard work and dedication put in throughout the
31 season and the hard work of the coaching staff; and

32 WHEREAS, the Hinds Community College Track and Field Teams
33 were superbly coached and tremendously inspired by Head Track and
34 Field Coach Reginald Dillon, who has helped each athlete refine
35 their skills in executing the perfect stance, sprint and dash
36 during their tenure at Hinds; and

37 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
38 recognize and honor the remarkable achievements of
39 student-athletes, especially those such as the Hinds Community
40 College Track and Field Teams, who have brought honor to their
41 school, their community and to the State of Mississippi:

42 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
43 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby
