- 8 many obstacles during this season to accomplish this great task;

- 10 WHEREAS, the 2024-2025 season began with a new head coach,
- 11 Angela McClure, and some devastating news that one of the Lady
- 12 Irish starting players from the 2023-2024 season had been
- 13 diagnosed with an aggressive cancer, and that the team lost four
- 14 other starting players (seniors, etc.), forcing the team to begin
- 15 its quest to a state title with a new generation of players and
- 16 with a special dedication of their season to their teammate,
- 17 Katherine Adams; and

18	WHEREAS, motivated by their need to honor their teammate and
19	overcome adversity, the Lady Irish once again made it to the state
20	championship game and clinched the title by defeating Tupelo
21	Christian Prep for the third year in a row by a score of 4-0; and
22	WHEREAS, many individual players on the team have also earned
23	great accolades, including Bella Jordan, who was named Most
24	Valuable Player of the game after leading the scoring with a hat
25	trick, and she was also named Sun Herald's Player of the Year in
26	2024; and
27	WHEREAS, Bella Jordan and Anna Katherine Thriffiley also
28	earned a spot on the Coast All-Star East Team for the second year
29	in a row and were the only goal scorers for the team during the
30	Coast All-Star game this year; and
31	WHEREAS, Anna Katherine Thriffiley was also named Coast
32	Female Player of the Year for the 2024-2025 season as well as
33	Offensive Player of the Game for the Coast All-Star game, and
34	Bella Jordan and Anna Katherine Thriffiley have both earned the
35	title "Student Athlete of the Week" during the 2024-2025 season
36	for their contributions as both students and athletes; and
37	WHEREAS, before this championship win, the team made its
38	first ever appearance in the state championship game under the
39	leadership of Coach Adam Smith during the 2020-2021 season, and
40	again during the 2021-2022 season, but came up short to Our Lady
41	Academy 0-2; and

- WHEREAS, the 2022-2023 season was a gamechanger for the team,
- 43 the Lady Irish returned to the South State Championship defeating
- 44 Our Lady Academy and went on to win its first State Championship
- 45 title in school history under the leadership of Coach Cassandra
- 46 Terry and Assistant Coach Angela McClure; and
- 47 WHEREAS, that same season, the team's win over Tupelo
- 48 Christian Prep (6-0) brought great honor to the team, players and
- 49 coach, when Linda Mustered received the Most Valuable Player award
- 50 for this game and Coach Terry was named Sun Herald's Coach of the
- 51 Year; and
- 52 WHEREAS, during the 2023-2024 season, the Lady Irish lost
- 53 five starting seniors, but still returned to capture the state
- 54 championship under the leadership of Head Coach Cassandra Terry
- 55 and Assistant Coach Angela McClure when they defeated Tupelo
- 56 Christian Prep 7-0, and Anna Katherine Thriffiley received the
- 57 Most Valuable Player award for this game after scoring a hat
- 58 trick; and
- 59 WHEREAS, the leadership of this St. Patrick team hopes to
- 60 continue to build a thriving soccer program in which players can
- 61 excel both on and off the field:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
- 63 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby
- 64 commend and congratulate the St. Patrick Women's Soccer Team,
