- 12 inspired young minds for six years, and continued her journey in
- 13 educational leadership as Assistant Principal at Lockard
- 14 Elementary, Principal of Moorhead Middle School, and later,
- 15 Principal at Ruleville Middle School; and
- 16 WHEREAS, believing wholeheartedly that "every child is
- 17 capable of learning," Dr. Davis has been a tireless advocate for
- 18 teacher support and professional development, recognizing that

- 19 happy and healthy educators are essential to cultivating students
- 20 who are college, career, and community ready; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Dr. Davis has led the Sunflower County Consolidated
- 22 School District to historic gains in academic achievement,
- 23 including maintaining a "B" rating for three consecutive years,
- 24 achieving the highest performance ranking among school districts
- 25 in the Mississippi Delta, and improving 140 points from an "F"
- 26 rating in 2018 to a score of 610 in 2024 ranking among the top
- 27 100 districts in the state; and
- 28 WHEREAS, under her visionary leadership, 9 out of 11 schools
- 29 in the district are now rated "C" or higher, and the district has
- 30 not had a school rated "F" since spring 2018, demonstrating a
- 31 transformative culture of excellence and accountability; and
- 32 WHEREAS, throughout her tenure, Dr. Davis has had a steady
- 33 hand in guiding our district from failing to thriving often met
- 34 with criticism, yet never wavering in her mission to improve the
- 35 lives of our students, and her resilience and steadfast focus have
