SENATE BILL NO. 2015

- AN ACT TO BAN THE INTENTIONAL RELEASE OF BALLOONS FILLED WITH LIGHTER-THAN-AIR GASES OUTDOORS; TO ALLOW FOR THE INTENTIONAL
- 3 RELEASE OF BALLOONS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; TO PROVIDE
- 4 PENALTIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Legislature finds that the release of
- 7 balloons into the atmosphere poses a danger and nuisance to the
- 8 environment, particularly to wildlife and marine animals.
- 9 (2) For the purpose of this section, the term "balloon"
- 10 means a bag made from rubber, latex, polychloroprene, nylon,
- 11 mylar, foil or any other material which is or can be filled with
- 12 lighter-than-air gases.
- 13 (3) It is unlawful to intentionally release a balloon
- 14 outdoors, to organize the release of a balloon outdoors or to
- 15 intentionally cause a balloon to be released outdoors, except
- 16 under any of the following circumstances:
- 17 (a) A balloon is released on behalf of a governmental
- 18 agency or pursuant to a governmental contract for scientific or
- 19 meteorological purposes;

20	(b) A hot air balloon is recovered after launching; or
21	(c) A balloon is released and remains indoors.
22	(4) Any person who violates this section shall, upon
23	conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined an assessmen
24	of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per balloon released.
25	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
26	and after July 1, 2025.
