SENATE BILL NO. 2111

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI'S TOUGHEST
2 KIDS FOUNDATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH
3 DESIGN, PREPLANNING, CONSTRUCTION, FURNISHING AND EQUIPPING OF
4 BUILDINGS AND RELATED FACILITIES AT CAMP KAMASSA IN COPIAH COUNTY,
5 MISSISSIPPI, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much of it as may be
8 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
9 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi's Toughest
10 Kids Foundation for the purpose of defraying costs associated with
11 design, preplanning, construction, furnishing and equipping of
12 buildings and related facilities at Camp Kamassa in Copiah County,
13 Mississippi, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and
14 ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 1,500,000.00.

15 **SECTION 2.** It is the intent of the Legislature that the
16 funds appropriated in Section 1 shall be provided for matching
17 funds under federal programs.

18 **SECTION 3.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
19 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund



20 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
21 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or
22 her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person,
23 officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

24 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
25 and after July 1, 2025.
