## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2151

AN ACT TO REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT, PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL AND AGRICULTURAL HIGH SCHOOL, AND CERTAIN STATE HIGH SCHOOLS, TO ADOPT AND SEND TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, NO LATER THAN JANUARY 1, 2026, A SPECIFIC POLICY BANNING THE 5 POSSESSION, OR RESTRICTING THE USE, OF CELL PHONES BY STUDENTS 6 DURING CLASS OR WHILE UNDER THE SUPERVISION AND CONTROL OF A 7 SCHOOL EMPLOYEE; TO PROVIDE THAT, IF A SCHOOL OR SCHOOL DISTRICT FAILS TO ADOPT AND TRANSMIT A POLICY AS REQUIRED, THE STATE 8 9 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL DEDUCT ONE DAY'S WORTH OF THE 10 SCHOOL'S OR DISTRICT'S FUNDS UNDER THE TOTAL FUNDING FORMULA FOR 11 EACH DAY AFTER JANUARY 1, 2026, THAT THE SCHOOL OR DISTRICT IS 12 NONCOMPLIANT; TO PROVIDE FOR POTENTIAL EXCEPTIONS WHICH ALLOW 13 STUDENTS TO POSSESS OR USE CELL PHONES UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; TO PROVIDE THAT SUFFICIENT CAUSE FOR SUSPENSION OR 14 15 EXPULSION MAY NOT CONSIST OF ONLY A VIOLATION OF THE CELL PHONE 16 POSSESSION AND USE POLICY DEVELOPED AND IMPLEMENTED UNDER THIS 17 ACT, EXCEPT THAT SUSPENSION MAY BE USED AS A DISCIPLINARY MEASURE 18 OF LAST RESORT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 20 **SECTION 1.** (1) (a) Each public school district, public 21 charter school and agricultural high school, the Mississippi Schools for the Deaf and the Blind, the Mississippi School of the 22 23 Arts, and the Mississippi School for Mathematics and Science 24 shall, no later than January 1, 2026, adopt and send to the State 25 Department of Education a specific policy banning the possession, or restricting the use, of cell phones by students during class or 26 ~ OFFICIAL ~ S. - 27 while under the supervision and control of a school employee. The
- 28 State Department of Education shall retain a copy of the policy on
- 29 file.
- 30 (b) If a school or school district fails to adopt and
- 31 transmit a policy as required in this subsection, the State
- 32 Department of Education shall deduct one (1) day's worth of the
- 33 school's or district's funds under the total funding formula for
- 34 each day after January 1, 2026, that the school or district is
- 35 noncompliant.
- 36 (2) In developing and adopting a policy under this section,
- 37 a school or district may include exceptions to allow a student to
- 38 possess or use a cell phone under any of the following
- 39 circumstances:
- 40 (a) In the case of an emergency, or in response to a
- 41 perceived threat of danger;
- 42 (b) When a licensed advanced practice registered nurse,
- 43 physician or surgeon determines that the possession or use of a
- 44 cell phone is medically necessary for the health or well-being of
- 45 the student; or
- 46 (c) When the possession or use of a cell phone is
- 47 required in a student's individualized education program.
- 48 (3) Students may be suspended or expelled from attendance at
- 49 school for sufficient cause; however, in no case may sufficient
- 50 cause for suspension or expulsion consist of only a violation of
- 51 the cell phone possession and use policy developed and implemented

- 52 under this section, except that suspension may be used as a
- 53 disciplinary measure of last resort.
- 54 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 55 and after July 1, 2025.
