## SENATE BILL NO. 2158

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE SCHOOL PRINCIPALS TO PERMIT
REPRESENTATIVES OF PATRIOTIC SOCIETIES TO SPEAK TO THE STUDENT
BODY REGARDING CIVIC INVOLVEMENT; TO PRESCRIBE THE PROCESS BY
WHICH SUCH SOCIETIES SHALL BE ALLOTTED DATES AND TIMES TO SPEAK;
AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) As used in this section, "patriotic society"
- 8 or "society" means a group or organization listed in Title 36 of
- 9 the United States Code that is intended to serve young people
- 10 under twenty-one (21) years of age.
- 11 (2) Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, the principal
- 12 of each school shall allow representatives of a patriotic society
- 13 the opportunity to speak with students during school hours to
- 14 inform the students about the civic involvement of the society, as
- 15 well as explain how students may participate or join the society.
- 16 (3) The patriotic society shall be given only one (1) day at
- 17 the beginning of each academic school year, as approved by the
- 18 principal, for the society to speak to the students at the school
- 19 for no more than ten (10) minutes.

- 20 (4) The patriotic society shall provide written notice to
- 21 the principal of the society's intent to speak to the students.
- 22 The principal shall provide written approval of the specific day
- 23 and time for the society to address the students.
- 24 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 25 and after July 1, 2025.
