SENATE BILL NO. 2175

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-3-95, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATEWIDE COORDINATOR FOR JUNIOR RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS (JROTC) PROGRAMS IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS SHALL HOLD A POSITION COMPARABLE TO AN EDUCATION PROGRAM ADMINISTRATOR OR SUPERVISOR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-3-95, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 37-3-95. (1) Subject to the availability of funding for
- 10 such purpose, the State Superintendent of Public Education shall
- 11 employ within the State Department of Education or, in the
- 12 alternative, contract with the Mississippi Military Department for
- 13 a statewide coordinator for Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps
- 14 (JROTC) programs in the public schools. If employed by the State
- 15 Department of Education, the JROTC statewide coordinator must be
- 16 an active or retired member of the military and must meet any
- 17 additional qualifications that may be established for the position
- 18 by the State Superintendent of Public Education * * * and shall

- 21 (2) The following are the powers and duties of the JROTC
- 22 statewide coordinator:
- 23 (a) To coordinate training of new JROTC instructors and
- 24 continuing education programs for certified instructors;
- 25 (b) To facilitate communication between JROTC programs
- 26 in the various public schools;
- 27 (c) To assist in organizing competitions among JROTC
- 28 units from different high schools;
- 29 (d) To assist in the development of the JROTC
- 30 curriculum;
- 31 (e) To compile information on scholarships available to
- 32 JROTC participants and to solicit support for such scholarships;
- 33 (f) To assist in establishing support groups for
- 34 parents of students participating in a JROTC program;
- 35 (q) To solicit and accept financial support for JROTC
- 36 programs from private sector donors;
- 37 (h) To promote the involvement of JROTC units within
- 38 their local communities;
- 39 (i) To facilitate interaction between JROTC units and
- 40 the Mississippi National Guard and Mississippi Air National Guard;
- 41 (j) To promote, in general, the JROTC program in high
- 42 schools throughout the state;
