## SENATE BILL NO. 2192

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-1-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 REQUIRE ANY NEW, RENEWAL OR DUPLICATE DRIVER'S LICENSE, TEMPORARY
- 3 DRIVING PERMIT OR COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE ISSUED TO A PERSON
- 4 UNDER THIS CHAPTER TO BEAR AN INDICATION OF THE SEX OF THE
- 5 INDIVIDUAL WHICH SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH THE SEX OF THE
- 6 INDIVIDUAL DETERMINED AT BIRTH; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 63-1-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 9
- 10 63-1-35. (1) The Commissioner of Public Safety shall
- prescribe the form of license issued pursuant to this article 11
- which shall, among other features, include a driver's license 12
- 13 number assigned by the Department of Public Safety. A licensee
- shall list his social security number with the department which 14
- 15 shall cross reference the social security number with the driver's
- license number for purposes of identification. Additionally, each 16
- license shall bear a full-face color photograph of the licensee in 17
- 18 such form that the license and the photograph cannot be separated.
- The photograph shall be taken so that one (1) exposure will 19

20 photograph the applicant and the application simultaneously on the

- 21 same film. The department shall use a process in the issuance of
- 22 a license with a color photograph that shall prevent as nearly as
- 23 possible any alteration, counterfeiting, duplication,
- 24 reproduction, forging or modification of the license or the
- 25 superimposition of a photograph without ready detection. The
- 26 photograph shall be replaced by the department at the time of
- 27 renewal. Drivers' licenses, including photographs appearing
- 28 thereon, may be renewed by electronic means according to rules and
- 29 regulations promulgated by the commissioner in conformity to
- 30 Section 27-104-33.
- 31 (2) The commissioner shall prescribe the form of license
- 32 issued pursuant to this article to licensees who are not United
- 33 States citizens and who do not possess a social security number
- 34 issued by the United States government. The license of such
- 35 persons shall include a number and/or other identifying features.
- 36 (3) Any new, renewal or duplicate driver's license,
- 37 temporary driving permit or commercial driver's license issued to
- 38 a person required to register as a sex offender pursuant to
- 39 Section 45-33-25 shall bear a designation identifying the licensee
- 40 or permittee as a sex offender.
- 41 (4) The commissioner is authorized to provide the new,
- 42 renewal or duplicate driver's license, temporary driving permit or
- 43 commercial driver's license to any honorably discharged veteran as
- 44 defined in Title 38 of the United States Code, and such license or
- 45 permit shall exhibit the letters "Vet" or any other mark

- 46 identifying the person as a veteran. The veteran requesting the
- 47 "Vet" designation shall present his DD-214, Military Retiree
- 48 Identification Card, United States Department of Veterans Affairs
- 49 Medical Identification Card, United States Department of Veterans
- 50 Affairs Identification Card or National Guard Form NGB 22. The
- 51 veteran requesting the "Vet" designation may present his DD-214,
- 52 Military Retiree Identification Card, United States Department of
- 53 Veterans Affairs Medical Identification Card, United States
- 54 Department of Veterans Affairs Identification Card or National
- 55 Guard Form NGB 22 in person at the Mississippi Department of
- 56 Public Safety Driver's License Station.
- 57 (5) Not later than July 1, 2021, the commissioner shall
- 58 develop and implement a driver's license or driving permit in
- 59 electronic format as an additional option for license or permit
- 60 holders. Acceptable electronic formats include display of
- 61 electronic images on a cellular phone or any other type of
- 62 electronic device.
- 63 (6) If false documents are provided by an individual for
- 64 purposes of obtaining a veteran driver's license, such action
- 65 shall be considered fraudulent use of identity under Section
- 66 97-19-85, Mississippi Code of 1972, and shall be punishable, upon
- 67 conviction, as a felony pursuant to the provisions of that
- 68 section.
- 69 (7) Any new, renewal or duplicate driver's license,
- 70 temporary driving permit or commercial driver's license issued to

- 72 the individual which shall be consistent with the sex of the
- 73 individual determined at birth. A court order that is
- 74 inconsistent with this subsection shall have no effect upon

- 76 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 77 and after July 1, 2025.
