SENATE BILL NO. 2368

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 77-11-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PROHIBIT PENALTIES GREATER THAN THE MAXIMUM CIVIL PENALTY IN 3 FEDERAL LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 77-11-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- amended as follows: 6
- 77-11-3. (1) Any person operating a public utility subject 7
- to the jurisdiction of the Mississippi Public Service Commission 8
- 9 under subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (d) of Section 77-3-3, and
- Section 77-3-5, who violates any provision of any Natural Gas 10
- 11 Pipeline Safety Standard adopted both by the United States
- Department of Transportation, pursuant to the provisions of the 12
- 13 Federal Natural Gas Pipeline Safety Act of 1968, and by the
- 14 commission pursuant to Article 1, Chapter 3, of this title, shall
- be subject to a civil penalty of not * * * more than the maximum 15
- 16 civil penalty provided pursuant to 49 USC § 60122 and 49 CFR
- 17 190.223.



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L 8	(2) Any such civil penalty may be imposed by the chancery
L 9	court of the county in which the violation occurs or in which the
20	person violating the same resides or has his or its principal
21	place of business, upon complaint of the commission and after
22	opportunity for a hearing thereon. Any such civil penalty may be
23	compromised by the commission, subject to the approval of the
24	court. In determining the amount of such penalty, or the amount
25	agreed upon in compromise, the appropriateness of such penalty to
26	the size of the business of the person charged, the gravity of the
27	violation and the good faith of the person charged in attempting
28	to achieve compliance, after notification of a violation, shall be
29	considered. The amount of such penalty, when finally determined,
30	or the amount agreed upon in compromise, may be deducted from any
31	sums owing by the State of Mississippi to the person charged or
32	may be recovered under judgment of said chancery court, and upon
33	collection shall be paid to the Treasury of the State of
34	Mississippi.

35 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after its passage.
