

## SENATE BILL NO. 2430

1       AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 17-25-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,  
2 TO PROHIBIT THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF ANY COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY  
3 FROM ENACTING OR ENFORCING ORDINANCES AUTHORIZING THE USE OF  
4 AUTOMATED RECORDING EQUIPMENT OR SYSTEMS TO ENFORCE COMPLIANCE  
5 WITH OR TO IMPOSE OR COLLECT ANY FINE, FEE OR PENALTY FOR  
6 VIOLATION OF ANY REQUIREMENT TO POSSESS OR MAINTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE  
7 LIABILITY INSURANCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8       BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9       **SECTION 1.** Section 17-25-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
10 amended as follows:

11       17-25-19. (1) (a) Neither the board of supervisors of any  
12 county nor the governing authority of any municipality shall  
13 adopt, enact or enforce any ordinance authorizing the use of  
14 automated recording equipment or systems to enforce compliance  
15 with traffic signals, traffic speeds or other traffic laws, rules  
16 or regulations on any public street, road or highway within this  
17 state or to impose or collect any civil or criminal fine, fee or  
18 penalty for any such violation.

19 (b) Any county or municipality using automated  
20 recording equipment or systems shall remove the equipment or  
21 system before October 1, 2009.

22                   (2) (a) Neither the board of supervisors of any county nor  
23 the governing authority of any municipality shall adopt, enact or  
24 enforce any ordinance authorizing the use of automated recording  
25 equipment or systems to enforce compliance with any requirement to  
26 possess or maintain motor vehicle liability insurance.

( \* \* \*3) For the purposes of this section, the term  
"automated recording equipment or systems" means a camera or  
optical device installed to work in conjunction with a traffic  
control signal or radar speed detection equipment, or both, and  
designed to record images that depict the license plate attached  
to the rear of a motor vehicle that is not operated in compliance  
with instructions of the traffic control signal \* \* \*, with the  
posted speed limit or with any requirement to possess or maintain  
motor vehicle liability insurance.

40           **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
41 and after July 1, 2025.
