SENATE BILL NO. 2519

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING, ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE 3 UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI, TO ENTER INTO LEASES AND SUBLEASES OF PROPERTY LOCATED THEREON FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENTERING INTO PUBLIC 5 PROPERTY LOCATED THEREON FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENTERING INTO PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS TO DEVELOP STUDENT HOUSING AND OTHER 6 7 FACILITIES TO BENEFIT THE UNIVERSITY; TO PROVIDE THAT THE TERM OF 8 SUCH LEASES SHALL NOT EXCEED 45 YEARS AND TWO ADDITIONAL OPTIONS 9 FOR A RENEWAL PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED FIVE YEARS; TO PROVIDE THAT 10 LEASES OR SUBLEASES ENTERED INTO BY THE BOARD SHALL BE PROTECTED 11 FROM ACTIONS OF SUCCESSOR BOARDS BASED ON THE BINDING SUCCESSOR 12 DOCTRINE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. (1) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions 14 of Higher Learning, acting on behalf of the University of 15 16 Mississippi, is authorized to enter into a long-term lease of all or any portion of certain real property under its control and 17 18 possession. The property described in this section shall be leased for a period not to exceed a term of forty-five (45) years 19 with two (2) additional options for renewal periods not to exceed 20 21 ten (10) years and one (1) additional option for a renewal period 22 not to exceed five (5) years, for the purposes of developing buildings, housing, parking garage facilities, dining halls and/or 23 S. - 24 other retail developments, and/or other spaces for the benefit of
- 25 the university. The property to be leased shall be more
- 26 particularly described upon completion of surveys, but are
- 27 currently described as follows:
- 28 "Kincannon" is located on the northern portion of
- 29 the core campus;
- "West Row" is located on the western portion of the 30 (b)
- 31 core campus;
- 32 "South Parking Lot" is located on the southern
- portion of the core campus; 33
- "South Campus Recreation Center" is located south 34 (d)
- of the core campus, across Highway 6; and 35
- 36 "Duff Center South" is located on the core campus. (e)
- 37 The lease and any amendments to the lease of all or any
- 38 portion of the real property authorized for lease under subsection
- 39 (1) of this section shall be subject to the approval of the Board
- 40 of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning.
- approved lease and any amendments to the lease shall not be 41
- 42 cancelled by successor boards based on the binding successor
- 43 doctrine.
- 44 SECTION 2. (1)The Board of Trustees of State Institutions
- 45 of Higher Learning, acting on behalf of the University of
- Mississippi, is authorized to enter into a long-term sublease of 46
- 47 all or any portion of the real property described in Section 1 of
- this act which is under its control and possession for a period 48

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- 49 not to exceed a term of forty-five (45) years with two (2)
- 50 additional options for renewal periods not to exceed ten (10)
- 51 years and one (1) additional option for a renewal period not to
- 52 exceed five (5) years.
- 53 (2) The sublease and any amendments to the sublease of all
- 54 or any portion of the real property described in Section 1 of this
- 55 act shall be subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees of
- 56 State Institutions of Higher Learning. The approved sublease and
- 57 any amendments to the sublease shall not be cancelled by successor
- 58 boards based on the binding successor doctrine.
- 59 **SECTION 3.** If all or any portion of the property described
- 60 in Section 1 of this act is leased, the University of Mississippi,
- 61 with the approval of the Board of Trustees of State Institutions
- 62 of Higher Learning, is authorized to negotiate all aspects of any
- 63 lease or sublease and any terms and ancillary agreements
- 64 pertaining to any lease or sublease as may be reasonably necessary
- 65 to effectuate the intent and purposes of this section and to
- 66 ensure a fair and equitable return to the state.
- 67 **SECTION 4.** (1) All proceeds derived or received from the
- 68 agreements and leases entered into under Sections 1 and 2 of this
- 69 act shall be deposited into a special fund and expended only for
- 70 the use and benefit of the University of Mississippi.
- 71 (2) At the end of the lease term provided in this act, the
- 72 property leased under the authority provided herein and all

- 73 improvements to such property shall revert to the University of
- 74 Mississippi.
- 75 (3) The State of Mississippi shall retain all mineral rights
- 76 to the real property leased under Section 1 of this act.
- 77 (4) The Department of Finance and Administration is
- 78 authorized to correct any discrepancies in the property described
- 79 in Section 1 of this act.
- 80 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 81 and after its passage.
