## SENATE BILL NO. 2587

AN ACT TO CREATE THE STATE TRUTH COMMISSION; TO PRESCRIBE
POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION; TO PROVIDE FOR THE
STABLISHMENT OF PROCEDURES TO INVESTIGATE GRIEVANCES REGISTERED
WITH THE COMMISSION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. There is created the State Truth Commission,
- 7 hereinafter referred to as the "commission." The commission shall
- 8 consist of five (5) members appointed by the Governor with the
- 9 advice and consent of the Senate. The Governor shall designate
- 10 one (1) of the members as chairman. Each member shall devote his
- 11 or her full time to the duties of his or her office and shall not
- 12 engage in any other business or profession or hold any other
- 13 public office.
- 14 **SECTION 2.** (1) The chairman of the commission may appoint
- 15 assistants, officers, employees, committees and consultants for
- 16 the commission as necessary and may prescribe their powers and
- 17 duties.

- 19 transfer and consolidate offices within the commission as
- 20 necessary for the efficient operation of the commission.
- 21 (3) In conducting the activities of the commission pursuant
- 22 to this act, the chairman of the commission may request and
- 23 receive assistance, information and data from any agency of the
- 24 state, any political subdivision of the state or any public
- 25 authority of the state.
- 26 **SECTION 3.** (1) The commission has the following powers and
- 27 duties:
- 28 (a) To advise and assist the Governor and the
- 29 Legislature in developing policies, plans and programs to increase
- 30 racial diversity and enhance racial harmony in the state;
- 31 (b) To foster and promote research and study in the
- 32 area of race relations;
- 33 (c) To investigate, review or take any other action as
- 34 it deems necessary to answer complaints or grievances filed with
- 35 the commission regarding any state or local government agency or
- 36 program;
- 37 (d) To make recommendations to administrators of state
- 38 agencies in keeping with paragraph (a) of this subsection;
- 39 (e) To visit, inspect and appraise the management of
- 40 state and local government programs;
- 41 (f) To establish procedures to assure the effective
- 42 investigation of grievances brought to the attention of the

- 43 commission concerning allegations of past racial problems. The
- 44 procedures shall include receipt of written complaints, interviews
- 45 of persons and on-site monitoring of conditions. In addition, the
- 46 commission shall establish procedures for the speedy and impartial
- 47 review of grievances;
- 48 (g) To place members of its staff, as it deems
- 49 appropriate, as an outside monitor if, in the judgment of the
- 50 commission, conditions warrant it;
- 51 (h) To establish, maintain and operate a training
- 52 program for personnel employed by any state or local government
- 53 agency or program for voluntary training opportunities;
- 54 (i) To collect and disseminate statistical and other
- 55 information and to undertake research, studies and analyses
- 56 through the personnel of the commission or in cooperation with any
- 57 public or private agency; and
- (j) To adopt, amend or rescind the rules and
- 59 regulations as necessary to perform the powers and duties of the
- 60 commission.
- 61 (2) The commission, any member of the commission or any
- 62 employee designated by the commission may require from any officer
- 63 or employee of a state or local government agency or program any
- 64 information necessary to carry out the powers and duties of the
- 65 commission.
- 66 (3) The commission, any member of the commission or any
- 67 employee designated by the commission may issue and enforce a

- 68 subpoena and a subpoena duces tecum, administer oaths and examine
- 69 persons under oath in accordance with civil laws and rules.
- 70 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 71 and after July 1, 2025.
