SENATE BILL NO. 2656

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-1031, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
TO MOVE THE FIRST UNITED STATES CONGRESSIONAL PRIMARY WITHIN THE
STATE OF MISSISSIPPI TO MARCH OF EACH YEAR IN WHICH CONGRESSMEN
ARE ELECTED; TO REPEAL SECTION 23-15-1083, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
1972, WHICH COORDINATES UNITED STATES CONGRESSIONAL PRIMARIES WITH
PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARIES WHEN BOTH WILL TAKE PLACE WITHIN THE SAME
YEAR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-15-1031, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 11 23-15-1031. * * * The first primary election for Congressmen
- 12 shall be held on the first Tuesday in * * * March of the years in
- 13 which congressmen are elected, and a second primary, if necessary,
- 14 shall be held four (4) weeks thereafter. * * * The election shall
- 15 be held in all districts of the state on the same day. Candidates
- 16 for United States Senator shall be nominated at the congressional
- 17 primary next preceding the general election at which a senator is
- 18 to be elected and in the same manner that congressmen are
- 19 nominated. The chair and secretary of the state executive
- 20 committee shall certify the vote for United States Senator to the

- 21 Secretary of State in the same manner that county executive
- 22 committees certify the returns of counties in general state and
- 23 county primary elections.
- 24 **SECTION 2.** Section 23-15-1083, Mississippi Code of 1972,
- 25 which coordinates United States congressional primaries with
- 26 presidential primaries when both will take place within the same
- 27 year, is repealed.
- 28 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 29 and after July 1, 2025.
