SENATE BILL NO. 2742

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-57-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO ALLOW FEES COLLECTED FROM ISSUANCE OF BIRTH CERTIFICATES TO BE
3 USED FOR PROGRAMS DEDICATED TO MATERNAL, INFANT AND CHILDREN'S
4 HEALTHCARE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 41-57-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7 amended as follows:

8 41-57-11. (1) Each local registrar shall be paid the sum of
9 One Dollar (\$1.00) for each birth and each death certificate
10 properly made out, and in the manner and on the form required by
11 the State Board of Health. Such sum shall be paid by the board of
12 supervisors of the county in which the births and deaths occurred,
13 upon certification made monthly to the board of supervisors by the
14 state registrar.

15 However, any local registrar shall receive only Fifty Cents
16 (50¢) for each birth and each death certificate sent in to the
17 Bureau of Vital Statistics improperly completed or sent in at a
18 later time than that fixed by the regulations of the State Board
19 of Health.



34 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
35 and after July 1, 2025.
