- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 41-57-57, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 9 41-57-57. In order to secure records of marriages and births
- 10 in the several counties in this state from the earliest records
- 11 down to the present time, the State Board of Health is hereby
- 12 authorized and empowered to make contract with the circuit clerks
- 13 or others of this state to compile for the bureau of vital
- 14 statistics complete lists of marriages in the various counties
- 15 from the earliest records down to the present time. In order to
- 16 complete these records by securing records of said marriages in
- 17 all said counties, the State Board of Health is hereby authorized
- 18 and empowered to deposit all * * * monies received as fees for
- 19 certified copies of births, deaths and marriages in the State

20	Treasury in a separate account to be used for the completion of
21	the vital statistics on marriages in the various counties, and for
22	clerical expenses and other expenses necessary for completion and
23	issuance of birth records. Said fund shall be paid out for said
24	purposes only on vouchers issued for these purposes by the State
25	Board of Health. When said statistics of past marriages in the
26	several counties shall have been completed and paid for, then all
27	of said funds that may remain on hand and all other such funds
28	collected for certified copies of birth, death and marriage
