SENATE BILL NO. 2751

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-149-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO REMOVE DISTRIBUTOR FROM PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN DISCRIMINATORY
3 ACTIONS RELATED TO ENTITIES THAT ARE PARTICIPATING OR AUTHORIZED
4 TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FEDERAL 340B DRUG DISCOUNT PROGRAM; AND FOR
5 RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** Section 41-149-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
8 amended as follows:

9 41-149-7. (1) A manufacturer * * * shall not deny,
10 restrict, prohibit, or otherwise interfere with, either directly
11 or indirectly, the acquisition of a 340B drug by, or delivery of a
12 340B drug to, a pharmacy that is under contract with a 340B entity
13 and is authorized under such contract to receive and dispense 340B
14 drugs on behalf of the covered entity unless such receipt is
15 prohibited by the United States Department of Health and Human
16 Services.

17 (2) A manufacturer * * * shall not interfere with a pharmacy
18 contracted with a 340B entity.



19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
20 and after July 1, 2025.
