SENATE BILL NO. 2758

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE MANUFACTURE, SALE OR DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD PRODUCTS PRODUCED FROM CULTURED ANIMAL CELLS; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COMMERCE AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO ADOPT RULES OR REGULATIONS AS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION; AND FOR
- 6 RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** (1) For the purposes of this section, the
- 9 term "cultivated food product" means any food product produced
- 10 from cultured animal cells.
- 11 (2) (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to manufacture,
- 12 sell, hold for sale, offer for sale or distribute any cultivated
- 13 food product in this state.
- 14 (b) Any person who violates this section shall be
- 15 guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by
- 16 a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by
- imprisonment in the county jail for not more than three (3)
- 18 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

- 19 (3) (a) A retail food establishment, as defined in Section
- 20 69-1-18, that sells or distributes cultivated food products in

- 21 violation of this section shall be subject to disciplinary action
- 22 pursuant to Section 69-1-18.
- 23 (b) The license of a retail food establishment may be
- 24 suspended or revoked if found by the Commissioner of Agriculture
- 25 and Commerce to be in violation of this section, as provided in
- 26 Section 69-1-18.
- 27 (4) (a) A retail food establishment that sells or
- 28 distributes cultivated food products in violation of this section
- 29 shall be subject to all enforcement measures as provided by rule
- 30 or regulation of the State Department of Health.
- 31 (b) The permit of a retail food establishment may be
- 32 suspended or revoked as provided by rule or regulation of the
- 33 State Department of Health upon conviction of an owner or an
- 34 employee of the establishment for a violation of this section in
- 35 connection with the establishment.
- 36 (5) The Department of Agriculture and Commerce and the State
- 37 Department of Health may adopt rules or regulations as necessary
- 38 to implement this section.
- 39 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 40 and after July 1, 2025.
