SENATE BILL NO. 2792

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 79-11-407, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY THAT A NONPROFIT CORPORATION THAT FAILS TO FILE TIMELY
- OR FAILS TO DISCLOSE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION
- MAY BE SUBJECT TO THE PENALTIES OF ADMINISTRATIVE DISSOLUTION; TO
- 5 REPEAL SECTION 79-11-391, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH
- 6 AUTHORIZES A STATUS REPORT OF A NONPROFIT CORPORATION; AND FOR
- 7 RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 79-11-407, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 11 79-11-407. (1) Each nonprofit corporation, as defined in
- Section 79-11-127(z), shall file an annual report with the 12
- 13 Secretary of State Business Services Division before May 15 of
- 14 each year on a form prescribed by the Secretary of State.
- (2) Each domestic nonprofit corporation and each foreign 15
- 16 nonprofit corporation authorized to transact business in this
- state shall deliver an annual report to the Secretary of State for 17
- 18 filing, on such date as may be established by the Secretary of
- State, which provides the following information: 19

20 (a) The name of the nonprofit corporation and the s
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- 21 or country or other foreign jurisdiction under whose law it is
- 22 organized;
- 23 (b) The name, email address and street or physical
- 24 address of its registered agent in this state;
- 25 (c) The address of its principal office;
- 26 (d) The name, titles and business address of its
- 27 principal officer;
- 28 (e) A brief description of the nature of its business;
- 29 and
- 30 (f) Whether it has received public funds and a listing
- 31 of any governmental entity that distributed the public funds. The
- 32 term "public funds" means funds received by the organization
- 33 during its most recently completed fiscal year which were received
- 34 from the State of Mississippi or any local governmental authority
- 35 located within the State of Mississippi.
- 36 (3) Information in the annual report must be current as of
- 37 the date the annual report is executed on behalf of the nonprofit
- 38 corporation.
- 39 (4) If an annual report does not contain the information
- 40 required by this section, the Secretary of State shall provide
- 41 written notice promptly to the reporting nonprofit corporation and
- 42 return the report for correction. If the report is corrected to
- 43 contain the information required by this section and delivered to

- 44 the Secretary of State within thirty (30) days after the effective
- 45 date of notice, the report is deemed to be timely filed.
- 46 (5) If the nonprofit corporation fails to file timely or
- 47 fails to disclose the information required under this section,
- 48 the corporation may be subject to the penalties of administrative
- 49 dissolution * * *.
- 50 (6) The requirements of this section shall not apply to
- 51 water associations as defined in Section 79-11-394.
- 52 **SECTION 2.** Section 79-11-391, Mississippi Code of 1972,
- 53 which authorizes a status report of a nonprofit corporation, is
- 54 repealed.
- 55 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 56 and after July 1, 2025.
