SENATE BILL NO. 2865

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-29-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2 REVISE THE DEFINITION OF THE TERM "POLYGRAPH EXAMINER" WITHIN THE
3 POLYGRAPH EXAMINERS LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 73-29-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6 amended as follows:

7 73-29-3. In this chapter, unless the context requires a
8 different definition:

9 "Board" means the polygraph examiners board * * *.

10 "Secretary" means that member of the polygraph examiners
11 board selected by the board to act as secretary * * *.

12 "Internship" means the study of polygraph examinations and of
13 the administration of polygraph examinations by a trainee under
14 the personal supervision and control of a polygraph examiner in
15 accordance with a course of study prescribed by the board at the
16 commencement of such internship * * *.

17 "Person" means any natural person, firm, association,
18 copartnership, or corporation * * *.



19 "Polygraph examiner" means any person who uses * * * a
20 polygraph instrument to test or question individuals for the
21 purpose of verifying truth of statements.

22 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
23 and after July 1, 2025.
