SENATE BILL NO. 2889

1 AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTIONS 41-20-1, 41-20-3, 41-20-5, 41-20-7,
2 41-20-9 AND 41-20-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH CREATE
3 WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION A POSITION
4 KNOWN AS THE COORDINATOR OF MENTAL HEALTH ACCESSIBILITY; PROVIDE
5 FOR APPOINTMENT, QUALIFICATIONS, EXPENSES AND SALARY FOR THE
6 POSITION; ESTABLISH POWERS, DUTIES AND DISCRETIONARY
7 RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POSITION; REQUIRE INTER-AGENCY COOPERATION
8 WITH THE COORDINATOR OF MENTAL HEALTH ACCESSIBILITY IN PERFORMING
9 HIS OR HER DUTIES; SET FORTH DEFINITIONS AND RELATED PROVISIONS;
10 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

12 **SECTION 1.** Sections 41-20-1, 41-20-3, 41-20-5, 41-20-7,
13 41-20-9 and 41-20-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, which create
14 within the Department of Finance and Administration a position
15 known as the Coordinator of Mental Health Accessibility, provide
16 for appointment, qualifications, expenses and salary for the
17 position, establish powers, duties and discretionary
18 responsibilities of the position, require inter-agency cooperation
19 with the Coordinator of Mental Health Accessibility in performing
20 his or her duties, and related provisions, are repealed.

21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
22 and after its passage.
