1 2 3 4	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS FOR LICENSED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Examiners
9	for Licensed Professional Counselors, for the purpose of defraying
10	the expenses of the board for the fiscal year beginning
11	July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026\$ 378,711.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1 of this act, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:
15	Permanent: 2
16	Time-Limited: 0
17	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
18	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

- 19 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 20 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 21 None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 22 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating
- 23 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 24 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 25 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 26 Mississippi State Board of Examiners for Licensed Professional
- 27 Counselors shall maintain complete accounting and personnel
- records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under 28
- 29 this act and that such records shall be in the same format and
- 30 level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2025. It is further
- 31 the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request
- 32 for Fiscal Year 2027 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
- Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the 33
- 34 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2026
- 35 budget request process.
- 36 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, One
- 37 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is allocated for expenses
- 38 related to updating the Licensing Management System.
- 39 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 40 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 41
- 42 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 43

- 44 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 45 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 46 made without competitive bids.
- 47 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 48 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 49 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 50 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 51 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 52 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 53 actions contrary to this provision.
- 54 **SECTION 7.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 55 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 56 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 57 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 58 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 59 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 60 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 61 and after July 1, 2025, and shall stand repealed from and after
- 62 June 30, 2025.
