SENATE BILL NO. 3029

1 2	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS TO THE MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Dental
7	Examiners, for the support of said board for the fiscal year
8	beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026
9	\$ 1,276,240.00.
LO	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
L1	this act, the following positions are authorized:
L2	AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:
L3	Permanent: 8
L 4	Time-Limited: 0
L 5	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
L 6	responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal
L 7	Services for Fiscal Year 2027 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2026 funds
L 8	appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are
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- 19 added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2026 budget by the Mississippi
- 20 Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's
- 21 personal services appropriation, which the State Personnel Board
- 22 shall publish. The agency's personal services appropriation may
- 23 consist of restricted funds for approved vacancies for Fiscal Year
- 24 2026 that may be utilized to fill vacant Fiscal Year 2025
- 25 headcount. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that
- 26 the funds provided for vacancies are used to increase headcount
- 27 and not for promotions, title changes, in-range salary adjustments
- 28 or any other mechanism for increasing salaries for current
- 29 employees. It is the Legislature's intention that no employee
- 30 salary falls below the minimum salary established by the
- 31 Mississippi State Personnel Board.
- 32 Additionally, the State Personnel Board shall determine and
- 33 publish the projected annualized payroll costs based on current
- 34 employees. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to
- 35 ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2026 do
- 36 not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. If
- 37 the agency's Fiscal Year 2026 projected cost exceeds the
- 38 annualized costs, no salary actions shall be processed by the
- 39 State Personnel Board except for new hires determined to be
- 40 essential for the agency.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 42 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or
- 43 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State

- 44 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 45 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 46 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 47 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 48 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 49 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for
- 52 salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are
- 53 withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 55 violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A
- 56 relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 57 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 59 Mississippi Board of Dental Examiners shall maintain complete
- 60 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 61 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 62 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 63 Year 2025. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 64 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2027 shall be
- 65 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 66 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 67 provided during the Fiscal Year 2026 budget request process.

- 68 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- 69 this act, an amount not to exceed Twenty-seven Thousand Dollars
- 70 (\$27,000.00) shall be allocated to the Mississippi Board of
- 71 Pharmacy to defray the expenses of the Mississippi Prescription
- 72 Monitoring Program.
- 73 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 74 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 75 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 76 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 77 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 78 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 79 actions contrary to this provision.
- 80 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 81 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 82 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 83 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 84 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 85 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 86 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 87 made without competitive bids.
- 88 **SECTION 7.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 89 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 90 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 91 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

- 92 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 93 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 94 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 95 and after July 1, 2025, and shall stand repealed from and after
- 96 June 30, 2025.
