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| 5 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: |
| 6 | SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be |
| 7 | necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General |
| 8 | Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Administrative Office of |
| 9 | Courts for CASA of Mississippi for the purpose of defraying costs |
| 10 | associated with the CASA Capacity Growth Program for the fiscal |
| 11 | year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026 |
| 12 | \$ 1,600,000.00. |
| 13 | SECTION 2. As a condition of receiving the funds |
| 14 | appropriated in Section 1 of this act, the Administrative Office |
| 15 | of Courts shall establish the CASA Capacity Growth Program to |
| 16 | award grants to local CASAs to aid in their mission to serve |
| 17 | abused and neglected children in courts. |
| 18 | SECTION 3. It is the intent of the Legislature that the CASA |
| 19 | Capacity Growth Program shall be developed and overseen by the |
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- 20 Administrative Office of Courts in conjunction with CASA of
- 21 Mississippi.
- 22 **SECTION 4.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
- 23 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
- 24 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
- 25 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or
- 26 her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person,
- 27 officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 28 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 29 and after July 1, 2025.
