SENATE BILL NO. 3191

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE NEWTON COUNTY SCHOOL
2 DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE
3 FINAL PHASE OF THE NEWTON COUNTY CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION
4 CENTER TO INCLUDE POWER ACADEMY EQUIPMENT, CULINARY ARTS
5 EQUIPMENT, INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT, UNMANNED AERIAL
6 SYSTEMS PROGRAM EQUIPMENT, AND THE INDUSTRY-SPECIFIC SIMULATION
7 SOFTWARE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much of it as may be
10 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
11 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Newton County School
12 District for the purpose of defraying costs associated with the
13 final phase of the Newton County Career and Technical Education
14 Center to include power academy equipment, culinary arts
15 equipment, industrial technology equipment, unmanned aerial
16 systems program equipment, and the industry-specific simulation
17 software for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending
18 June 30, 2026.....\$ 426,000.00.

19 **SECTION 2.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
20 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund



21 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
22 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or
23 her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person,
24 officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

25 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
26 and after July 1, 2025.
