SENATE BILL NO. 3256

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-5-171, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO STIPULATE THAT THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE TISHOMINGO COUNTY WATER 3 DISTRICT SHALL BE COMPENSATED FOR THEIR SERVICES AT A RATE UP TO \$84.00 PER DAY UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 19-5-171, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 8 19-5-171. - 80 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
