SENATE BILL NO. 3278

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO MELVIN JACKSON OF MONROE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Melvin Jackson of Monroe County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction for false pretenses in 2001 in Lowndes County,
- 8 Mississippi. He was convicted of the crime of false pretenses,
- 9 and on August 20, 2001, was sentenced to serve three (3) years
- 10 probation in the custody of the Mississippi Department of
- 11 Corrections.
- 12 A search of the Mississippi Department of Corrections records
- 13 did not produce a discharge affidavit, but Jackson has represented
- 14 that he completed all terms and conditions of his sentence. The
- 15 Legislature is informed that he has since conducted himself as a
- 16 law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2025.
