## SENATE BILL NO. 3281

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO FREDERICK KENYON CLARK OF LEAKE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Frederick Kenyon Clark of Leake County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction for the crime of armed robbery in Attala County,
- 8 Mississippi. On September 10, 1998, in Attala County,
- 9 Mississippi, he was sentenced to serve six (6) years in the
- 10 custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections.
- On September 8, 2004, he was discharged from the custody of
- 12 the Mississippi Department of Corrections due to the expiration of
- 13 his sentence. He completed all terms and conditions of his
- 14 sentence. The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted
- 15 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
- 16 lawful manner.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2025.
