SENATE BILL NO. 3281

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO FREDERICK KENYON
2 CLARK OF LEAKE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Frederick Kenyon Clark of Leake County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction for the crime of armed robbery in Attala County,
8 Mississippi. On September 10, 1998, in Attala County,
9 Mississippi, he was sentenced to serve six (6) years in the
10 custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections.

11 On September 8, 2004, he was discharged from the custody of
12 the Mississippi Department of Corrections due to the expiration of
13 his sentence. He completed all terms and conditions of his
14 sentence. The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted
15 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
16 lawful manner.

17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
18 and after July 1, 2025.
