SENATE BILL NO. 3285

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO HEATHER DAWN SOUTH
2 (ROGERS) WICKS OF TISHOMINGO COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED
3 PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
6 completely restored to Heather Dawn South (Rogers) Wicks of
7 Covington County, Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector
8 as a result of her conviction for the crime of embezzlement. On
9 January 5, 2005, in Tishomingo County, Mississippi, she was
10 sentenced to serve ten (10) years in the Mississippi Department of
11 Corrections, with one (1) year to serve and five (5) years of
12 probation post-release.

13 On January 5, 2006, she was discharged from the physical
14 custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections due to the
15 expiration of her sentence. She represents that she has completed
16 all terms and conditions of her sentence. The Legislature is
17 informed that she has since conducted herself as a law-abiding and
18 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.



19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
20 and after July 1, 2025.
