SENATE BILL NO. 3290

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JERLEAN CUMMINGS OF CLAY COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Jerlean Cummings of Clay County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her
- 7 conviction for the crime of false pretenses on July 18, 1997, in
- 8 Clay County, Mississippi. On January 22, 2025, the Mississippi
- 9 Department of Corrections represented that after a complete search
- 10 of its records, the department was unable to locate any
- 11 information other than Jerlean Cummings' Inmate Time Sheet.
- 12 Cummings represents that she was finally discharged from the
- 13 department on completion of her sentence, and her Inmate Time
- 14 Sheet reflects an end date of July 18, 2000. She completed all
- 15 terms and conditions of her sentence. The Legislature is informed
- 16 that she has since conducted herself as a law-abiding and
- 17 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

18 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

19 and after July 1, 2025.
