- 22 Hicks, Director of "Visit Mississippi." "This recognition honors
- 23 not only the creativity of the artists who brought the float to
- 24 life but also the profound impact Mississippi musicians have had
- 25 on the world"; and
- 26 WHEREAS, "Visit Mississippi" thanks sponsors "Visit Jackson,"
- 27 B.B. King Museum and Delta Interpretive Center, Coastal
- 28 Mississippi, and "Visit Tupelo"; and
- 29 WHEREAS, "Mississippi Tourism Association works hand in hand
- 30 with Visit Mississippi," said Jennie Guido of Natchez who works
- 31 for the Mississippi Tourism Association. There are several days
- 32 of activities leading up to the parade. It was the media's
