SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 19

A RESOLUTION CALLING UPON THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO PASS LEGISLATION REPEALING THE FACE ACT AND CALLING UPON PRESIDENT TRUMP TO PARDON PRO-LIFE AMERICANS UNJUSTLY CONVICTED THEREUNDER.

WHEREAS, the FACE Act, 18 U.S.C. § 248, was enacted by the

5 United States Congress and signed into law by President Bill

Clinton in 1994 to prohibit individuals from interfering with

7 access to so-called "reproductive health services," which include

8 both abortion facilities and pregnancy resource centers; and

9 WHEREAS, first-time FACE Act offenders face a penalty of up

10 to 12 months in jail and a \$15,000 fine, and repeat offenders can

11 receive up to three years of jail time and \$25,000 in fines; and

12 WHEREAS, according to World magazine, since a draft Supreme

13 Court opinion overturning Roe v. Wade was leaked in the Dobbs v.

14 Jackson Women's Health Center case in early May 2022, "The DOJ

15 began pairing standard FACE Act indictments with charges of

16 'conspiracy against rights,'" which carries penalties of up to a

17 "10-year prison sentence and its own fines"; and

L 8	WHEREAS, according to a report updated November 12, 2024, by
L 9	Catholic Vote, since the Dobbs leak at least 95 pregnancy resource
20	centers and pro-life groups have been attacked and vandalized; and
21	WHEREAS, according to the Family Research Council, in the
22	year following that leak, at least 38 "churches across the country
23	have been firebombed, smashed, ransacked or vandalized with
24	pro-abortion graffiti and threatening messages," and there were at
25	least 23 "'other incidents' in which pro-abortion protesters were
26	arrested or pro-life individuals were physically attacked"; and
27	WHEREAS, according to an October 20, 2022, Fox News Digital
28	report, although radical left-wing pro-abortion group Jane's
29	Revenge had claimed credit for more than a dozen attacks on
30	churches or pregnancy resource centers, "not a single member of
31	the underground group has been arrested"; and
32	WHEREAS, according to a May 12, 2022, report by the Wisconsin
33	State Journal, Jane's Revenge proclaimed it was at "war" with
34	pro-life groups, demanded "the disbanding of all anti-choice
35	establishments" and said the first attack was "only a warning";

37	WHEREAS, despite the numerous serious attacks and threats
88	upon the pro-life community, according to Catholic Vote's data
39	updated November 11, 2024, there have been only five reported
10	arrests in connection with the attacks on the pro-life community;

         WHEREAS, according to the aforementioned Alliance Defending

    Freedom article, in October 2021, devout Christian Mark Houck was
    praying with his son outside a Philadelphia, Pennsylvania,

    abortion clinic when a Planned Parenthood escort repeatedly "got

    in the face of Houck and his son" and made vulgar comments,

    leading Houck to push the Planned Parenthood escort to get him
    away from his son; and

         WHEREAS, the aforementioned Alliance Defending Freedom

    article further stated that state and local authorities brought no

    charges against Houck, but the Biden Department of Justice did so

    and, despite Houck's offer to turn himself in, "The FBI sent
    'twenty heavily armed federal agents' to Houck's house in the

    early morning hours, pointed at least five guns at him, his wife,
    and his children, and then arrested him," yet it took a federal

- 67 jury less than three hours to find Houck not guilty of the charges
- 68 brought against him; and
- 69 WHEREAS, in another example of the Biden administration's
- 70 persecution of the pro-life community, according to his written
- 71 testimony submitted December 18, 2024, to a subcommittee of the
- 72 United States House of Representatives' Judiciary Committee, and
- 73 further as reported by the National Catholic Register, father of
- 74 11 and small business owner, Paul Vaughn, was arrested in the
- 75 early morning hours at his home at gunpoint by an FBI swat team,
- 76 to the horror of his wife and seven of his children who were home,
- 77 all for merely praying outside an abortion clinic, after which
- 78 Vaughn was subjected to a lengthy prosecution and federal trial
- 79 and sentenced to three years of supervised release, even though
- 80 the lead negotiator for the local police department, who Vaughn
- 81 interacted with on the day of the alleged "crime," testified on
- 82 his behalf at the trial, and video evidence showed that Vaughn had
- 83 not blocked any facility entrances; and
- 84 WHEREAS, by his own public account, as broadcast by the
- 85 American Family Association (AFA), emergency room physician,
- 86 pastor, and father of 13, Dr. Coleman Boyd, was put under felony
- 87 indictment under the FACE Act, paired with felony conspiracy
- 88 charges, forced to give up his firearms, and placed under travel
- 89 restrictions blocking international mission work, as if he were a
- 90 terrorist, and, according to an article in Zenit magazine,
- 91 "sentenced to six months of house arrest, five years of probation,

92	and a \$110,000 fine," then lost his job as a result of his
93	sentencing; and
94	WHEREAS, according to an article in The Daily Signal,
95	89-year-old concentration camp survivor Eva Edl faced over a
96	decade in prison and received three years of probation for her
97	nonviolent protest of the same destruction of human life she saw
98	in her youth at a communist death camp; and
99	WHEREAS, according to an article by the National Catholic
100	Register, in yet another example of the Biden administration's
101	abuse of power using the FACE Act, Bevelyn Beatty Williams, a
102	33-year-old pro-life activist, was sentenced to three-and-a-half
103	years in prison after her protest at an abortion facility, with
104	the judge mercilessly taking her away from her daughter, a
105	toddler, for that child's formative years; and
106	WHEREAS, this long train of abuses under the FACE Act has
107	demonstrated that the FACE Act has been weaponized and made a tool
108	of injustice and violation of law-abiding Americans'
109	constitutional rights, and has further demonstrated that the FACE
110	Act has been so irrevocably tainted by the Biden administration's
111	politicized prosecutions and is so unavoidably subject to
112	prosecutorial abuse that United States Senator Mike Lee and
113	Representative Chip Roy have introduced legislation to repeal the

FACE Act, in support of which Senator Lee stated that "the Biden

116	pro-life sidewalk counselors while failing to protect pregnancy
117	centers and churches from violent attacks"; and
118	WHEREAS, despite the FBI's and DOJ's blatant abuses of the
119	FACE Act and the scandalously historic number of pardons and
120	clemencies the Biden administration has issued, including of his
121	own disgraced son, admitted felon Hunter Biden, whom he falsely
122	promised he would never pardon, President Biden has provided no
123	relief to the pro-life Americans unjustly persecuted by his
124	administration for exercising their rights to free speech and
125	religious liberty in opposition to abortion:
126	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
127	MISSISSIPPI, That we call upon the United States Congress to
128	forthwith pass, and President Donald J. Trump to speedily sign,
129	legislation repealing the FACE Act.
130	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that we call upon President Donald J.
131	Trump to forthwith pardon or grant clemency to all Americans
132	unjustly convicted under the FACE Act for exercising their
133	constitutional rights to protest at abortion clinics.
