- 5 Monticello, Mississippi, is the first representative from this
- 6 state to win the National "Miss Teen USA" title in 37 years; and
- 7 WHEREAS, August 1, 2024, will be a day 17-year-old Addie
- 8 Carver will always remember. "It's been something that I've been
- 9 working so hard for a very long time, "Carver said. "So living
- 10 out this dream that I've had since I was a little girl just means
- 11 the world"; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Addie stated, "I'm from a very small town,
- 13 Monticello, Mississippi. Not many people live there, but we're
- 14 such a close-knit community, and that's what I really love about
- 15 it. They recently named a day after me at my homecoming
- 16 ceremonies"; and

- 17 WHEREAS, Addie Carver, Miss Teen USA, is making headlines not
- 18 only for winning the national title, but for her work in dance and
- 19 as founder and CEO of her own social media company; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Carver is not only the founder and CEO of her own
- 21 social media company, she is a dance teacher and choreographer.
- 22 She teaches dance three to four nights a week. Carver said,
- 23 "Dance knows no age, no background and no race, and more than
- 24 anything, dance can save a life just like it saved mine. So
- 25 that's a big message I want to share this year." Carver credits
- 26 dance with saving her life after losing her father; and
- 27 WHEREAS, this is Carver's senior year. She is making plans
- 28 for college and her future career. Miss Teen USA says she intends
- 29 to attend the University of Southern Mississippi. Her plan is to
- 30 have a career in Marketing; and
- 31 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this young
- 32 Mississippi citizen whose accomplishments have made history and
- 33 brought pride to her family, her community and to the State of
- 34 Mississippi:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 36 MISSISSIPPI, That we hereby commend and congratulate Addie Carver
- 37 from Monticello as the first representative from Mississippi since
