## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 41

- A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE RECOGNITION OF THE MISSISSIPPI SENATE TO THE ICONIC GOSPEL GROUP THE WILLIAMS BROTHERS IN HONOR OF THEIR CONTINUING MUSICAL AND CULTURAL LEGACY.
- 4 WHEREAS, few gospel groups can equal The Williams Brothers in
- 5 terms of longevity. Organized in 1960 by their late father, Leon
- 6 "Pop" Williams, and late brother, Frank Williams, the group now
- 7 consists of Doug and Melvin Williams, Henry Green and Andre Tate;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, originally based in the southwest Mississippi Town
- 10 of Smithdale and called The Little Williams Brothers, the group
- 11 toured on weekends, returning home by Monday to attend school.
- 12 They quickly built a following and dropped the word "Little" from
- 13 their name, settling on the Sensational Williams Brothers and
- 14 later simply "The Williams Brothers"; and
- 15 WHEREAS, in the late 1960s, the group recorded two singles
- 16 for a small Jackson label called Delta. In 1971, the group
- 17 reached a national audience through a split-sided album with the
- 18 Jackson Southernaires, a group that featured two other Williams

- 19 brothers, Huey and Frank. Around this time, session drummer
- 20 Maurice Surrell joined the group. Throughout the 1970s, the group
- 21 toured extensively on the success of numerous albums and hit
- 22 singles, for labels like Nashboro, Savoy, Tomato, and New Birth
- 23 Records. The 1980s saw the group settle in at Jackson's Malaco
- 24 Records, where they recorded several more popular, award-winning
- 25 albums; and
- 26 WHEREAS, in 1991, The Williams Brothers formed Blackberry
- 27 Records in Ridgeland. Their first release on Blackberry won a
- 28 Stellar Award and was nominated for a Grammy. They have been
- 29 inducted as members of the International Gospel Hall of Fame.
- 30 Over the years, they have performed at some of the most hallowed
- 31 venues in the world, including Madison Square Garden, the Apollo
- 32 Theater, Radio City Music Hall and Carnegie Hall. The Williams
- 33 Brothers were the first gospel headliner to appear at the Hard
- 34 Rock Hotel and Casino; and
- 35 WHEREAS, the group has recorded three Billboard Number 1
- 36 albums and 18 Top Ten Albums. Altogether, they have released more
- 37 than 42 albums. The Williams Brothers have shared the stage with
- 38 Stevie Wonder, Brandy, Charley Pride, Jerry Lee Lewis, Patti
- 39 LaBelle, James Taylor, and many others. In 2015, they performed
- 40 at the White House with Aretha Franklin for former President
- 41 Barack Obama; and



42	WHEREAS, demand for their live performances has taken them to
43	venues across the United States and abroad. They have one of the
44	most loyal fan bases in gospel music; and
45	WHEREAS, when the Governor's Arts Awards Program announced
46	its 2022 recipients, the iconic gospel group The Williams Brothers
47	were included for Lifetime Achievement in Music; and
48	WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we pay tribute and
49	express appreciation for the talent of a world-class Mississippi
50	gospel group that has made Mississippi a better place and
51	exemplifies the musical traditions of our great state:
52	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
53	MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby extend the recognition of the
54	Mississippi Legislature to The Williams Brothers in honor of their
55	continuing musical and cultural legacy, and extend our
56	congratulations to this mighty gospel group for their many
57	contributions.
