SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 43

1 A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE CONGRATULATIONS OF THE MISSISSIPPI
2 SENATE TO COACH GLENN DAVIS UPON HIS RETIREMENT AS LONGEST-SERVING
3 HEAD FOOTBALL COACH AT COPIAH-LINCOLN COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

4 WHEREAS, Copiah-Lincoln Community College announced on
5 October 10, 2024, longtime Head Coach Glenn Davis is retiring
6 after leading the Wolves football program for the last 21 seasons;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, Coach Glenn Davis is the longest-serving head coach
9 in Copiah-Lincoln Community College's school history, ending his
10 career with a 114-81 record, a MACJC state title, and four seasons
11 as MACJC runners-up; and

12 WHEREAS, he is the all-time winningest head football coach in
13 Co-Lin history and was selected as MACJC Coach of the Year in
14 2006, 2014, and 2018, and MACCC South Coach of the Year in 2023;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, over 250 of his student athletes went on to sign and
17 play at four-year universities, with several continuing careers in
18 the National Football League; and



19 WHEREAS, Coach Davis was inducted into the Co-Lin Sports Hall
20 of Fame by the Athletic Alumni Association in 2020; and

21 WHEREAS, "While we reflect on Coach Davis's time with us, we
22 not only celebrate the success he achieved on the field, but also
23 the integrity and dedication he brought to our entire program,"
24 said CLCC President Dr. Dewayne Middleton in a release by the
25 school. "His legacy will be remembered not just in victories, but
26 in the countless lives he touched, the character he shaped, and
27 his dedication to both his career and the lives of his student
28 athletes and the standards of excellence he set for his players.
29 Co-Lin will remember Coach Davis for his dedication to both his
30 career and the lives of his student athletics. Coach Davis will
31 leave a lasting impact far beyond his time as head football coach.
32 We are deeply grateful for his years of service, and we wish him
33 all the best in this well-earned next chapter":
