SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 60

- A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE CONGRATULATIONS OF THE MISSISSIPPI SENATE TO PHILADELPHIA EAGLES RUNNING BACK AND FORMER YAZOO COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL QUARTERBACK KENNETH GAINWELL FOR HIS OUTSTANDING 2025 SUPERBOWL CHAMPIONSHIP PERFORMANCE.
- 5 WHEREAS, as the final seconds ticked off the clock and
- 6 brought the end to the 2024-2025 NFL season, Philadelphia Eagles
- 7 Running Back and former Yazoo County High School Quarterback
- 8 Kenneth Gainwell realized his lifelong dream of becoming a Super
- 9 Bowl Champion. In the Eagles 40-22 rout over the Kansas City
- 10 Chiefs, Gainwell had six carries for ten yards; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Kenneth Gainwell grew up in Yazoo City, Mississippi,
- 12 and attended Yazoo County High School. He was a three-year
- 13 starter quarterback for the Panthers. As a junior, he passed for
- 14 1,184 yards and nine touchdowns and rushed for 1,292 yards and 20
- 15 touchdowns; and
- 16 WHEREAS, during the summer going into his senior season,
- 17 Gainwell committed to playing college football at Memphis State
- 18 University over offers from Ole Miss and Tulane. As a senior at
- 19 Yazoo County High School, he passed for 1,139 yards and ten

- 20 touchdowns and ran for 1,834 yards and 32 touchdowns. Gainwell
- 21 was named Class 3A Mr. Football as he led the Panthers to a 14-1
- 22 record and an appearance in the Class 3A State Championship Game.
- 23 Gainwell finished his high school career with 3,682 yards passing
- 24 and 32 passing touchdowns and 4,730 rushing yards and 75 rushing
- 25 touchdowns with one kickoff returned for a touchdown; and
- 26 WHEREAS, Gainwell moved to running back during summer
- 27 training camp and played in four games as a true freshman before
- 28 deciding to redshirt the rest of the season. He finished the
- 29 season with four carries for 91 yards and a touchdown, a 73-yard
- 30 run, and six receptions for 52 yards; and
- 31 WHEREAS, as a redshirt freshman, Gainwell was named the
- 32 Tigers' starting running back following the departure of Tony
- 33 Pollard. He was named the co-American Athletic Conference (AAC)
- 34 Player of the Week after rushing for 104 yards and a touchdown and
- 35 gaining 204 yards and scoring two touchdowns on nine receptions on
- 36 October 19, 2019, in a 47-17 win over Tulane. He rushed for 1,459
- 37 yards with 13 touchdowns on 231 carries and caught 51 passes for
- 38 610 yards and three touchdowns and was named the AAC Freshman of
- 39 the Year and first-team All-AAC. He was named a second-team
- 40 All-American by the Sporting News and the American Football
- 41 Coaches Association and the National Freshman of the Year by the
- 42 Football Writers Association of America; and
- WHEREAS, Gainwell was selected in the fifth round (150th
- 44 overall) by the Philadelphia Eagles in the 2021 NFL draft.

- 45 Gainwell was happy to be drafted by Philadelphia, as he grew up an
- 46 Eagles fan, and his favorite player while growing up, Darren
- 47 Sproles, works for the team as a consultant. Gainwell also said
- 48 that he modeled his game after Sproles. He signed his four-year
- 49 rookie contract with Philadelphia on June 3, 2021. Gainwell found
- 50 moderate success as a rookie, as he ended the year with 68 carries
- 51 for 291 yards and five touchdowns, while adding 33 receptions for
- 52 253 yards and one touchdown; and
- 53 WHEREAS, in the 2022 season, Gainwell had 53 carries for 240
- 54 rushing yards and four rushing touchdowns to go along with 23
- 55 receptions for 169 receiving yards. In the team's 38-7 Divisional
- 56 Round victory over the New York Giants, he had 10 carries for a
- 57 career-high 112 yards and a touchdown, as well as one reception
- 58 for nine yards. This performance made him just the sixth Eagles
- 59 player to rush for at least 100 yards in a postseason game.
- 60 Gainwell helped the Eagles reach Super Bowl LVII where they lost
- 61 38-35 to the Kansas City Chiefs. In the Super Bowl, Gainwell had
- 62 seven carries for 21 rushing yards and four receptions for 20
- 63 receiving yards; and
- 64 WHEREAS, in the 2023 season, he had 84 carries for 364
- 65 rushing yards and two rushing touchdowns to go with 30 receptions
- 66 for 183 receiving yards. In the 2024 season, Gainwell had 75
- 67 carries for 290 rushing yards and one rushing touchdown to go with
- 68 16 receptions for 116 receiving yards to go with some kick return

- 69 duties. In Super Bowl LIX, he had six carries for ten yards in
- 70 the 40-22 win over the Chiefs; and
- 71 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize a
- 72 Mississippi professional athlete who has brought honor on a
- 73 national stage to his community and to the State of Mississippi:
- 74 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 75 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby extend and congratulate
- 76 Philadelphia Eagles running back and former Yazoo County High
- 77 School Quarterback Kenneth Gainwell for his outstanding 2025
- 78 Superbowl Championship performance and convey to Kenneth and his
- 79 family our best wishes for future success.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be presented to
- 81 Eagles Running Back Kenneth Gainwell, forwarded to the President
- 82 of the Philadelphia Eagles, the Yazoo County Superintendent, and
- 83 be made available to the Capitol Press Corps.
