- A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING SHELBY MCEWEN FROM ABBEVILLE, MISSISSIPPI, FOR HIS OUTSTANDING TRACK-AND-FIELD CAREER AND FOR TYING FOR THE GOLD MEDAL IN AN EPIC HIGH JUMP FINAL IN THE 2024 SUMMER OLYMPICS.
- 5 WHEREAS, during the 2024 Summer Olympics in Paris, Shelby
- 6 McEwen, a native of Abbeville, Mississippi, jumped a 2.36 meter
- 7 high jump and was tied for the lead with New Zealand's Hamish
- 8 Kerr. Both men were offered the option to share the gold medal.
- 9 Kerr wanted to proceed to a jump-off, and McEwen agreed. McEwen
- 10 lost to Kerr and won the silver medal in the epic high jump final;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, from 2015 to 2017, Shelby McEwen attended Northwest
- 13 Mississippi Community College. He was a member of the basketball
- 14 team and competed unattached in track and field. He then started
- 15 competing for the Alabama Crimson Tide, and participated in the
- 16 indoor and outdoor track seasons in 2018 and 2019; and
- WHEREAS, in 2019, he jumped a 2.31 meter high jump indoor and
- 18 then a 2.30 meter high jump outdoor, as second at 2019 USA Track &

- 19 Field Outdoor Championships in Doha, Qatar, where he was the first
- 20 nonqualifier for the final; and
- 21 WHEREAS, on May 22, 2021, he jumped a 2.33 meter high jump at
- 22 Roy P. Drachman Stadium in Tucson, Arizona, the qualifying
- 23 standard for the 2020 Olympic Summer Games, before finishing third
- 24 with a 2.30 meter high jump at the 2020 U.S. Olympic Trials. He
- 25 finished twelfth at the 2020 Summer Olympics with a jump of 2.27
- 26 meters; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Shelby claimed the silver medal in the famous 2024
- 28 Summer Olympic final and represented the United States in the
- 29 World Indoor Championship in Glasgow, Scotland. It is with great
- 30 pride that we recognize this track and field star who has brought
- 31 honor to his family, his community and to the State of
- 32 Mississippi:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 34 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Shelby
- 35 McEwen from Abbeville, Mississippi, for his outstanding track and
- 36 field career and for tying for the gold medal in an epic high jump
- 37 final in the 2024 Summer Olympics and extend to Shelby and his
- 38 family our best wishes for future success.
