- WHEREAS, we join the students, faculty, administration and
- 5 parents of Brandon High School in honoring the Brandon
- 6 Cheerleading Team for winning the National Cheerleading
- 7 Association's National Championship for a record-breaking sixth
- 8 time; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Brandon is the first Cheer Squad in the 75-year
- 10 history of the NCA competition to win back-to-back Grand National
- 11 Championships. The teams also won National Championships in the
- 12 Advanced Crowd Performance, Varsity and Advanced Crowd
- 13 Performance, and Junior Varsity/Freshman categories; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the team begins preparing for the NCA competition in
- 15 March. The routine is choreographed by Will Emmons and Storm
- 16 Chaffin of Southern Athletics. The team has only performed

- 17 publicly four times at the regional and state competitions and
- 18 twice at the NCA Nationals. However, the team does not spend its

- 19 entire year focusing on that one routine. They also prepare
- 20 routines for athletic contests, pep rallies and other school
- 21 events; and
- 22 WHEREAS, many factors contribute to Brandon's success. The
- 23 school, unlike many in the area, has its own nine-mat practice
- 24 facility equipped with a 72-inch screen television, wi-fi and a
- 25 state-of-the-art sound system. The girls are also no strangers to
- 26 competitive cheer. Almost all of them are members of an All-Star
- 27 Cheerleading Team. The squad's success prompted cheer and dance
- 28 powerhouse Varsity Spirit to feature them in a documentary on
- 29 Varsity TV. The show, which has followed the team since the fall
- 30 of 2020, begins at tryouts and follows the ladies through two
- 31 seasons of preparations and competitions. It is the most watched
- 32 series that Varsity TV has ever produced; and
- 33 WHEREAS, Brandon Over Everything (BOE) is the cheer team's
- 34 motto and mission. The squad has become well-known for their
- 35 amazing ability to cheer for others, but its most impactful
- 36 ability is the way the girls rally for each other; and
