- 23 semi-finals and went into the finals in first place against 11
- 24 teams and won. After 2 hours, they took the mat at the awards
- 25 ceremony and defended their title as back-to-back National
- 26 Champions in their division; and

- 28 School Cheerleading Coach, Liz McDonald, the team has won several
- 29 championships, including the 2022 MHSAA 6th State Champions and
- 30 now the 2024 and 2025 UCA National Championship; and
