- State Department of Health effective after the 2025 Regular 8
- Session of the Legislature; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Melissa White Parker has been employed by the
- Mississippi State Department of Health since June 1, 1991; and 11
- 12 WHEREAS, beginning her career with the Department of Health
- in June of 1991, Melissa was a Health Physicist in Radiological 13
- 14 Health and later transferred to the Bureau of Public Water Supply
- 15 as a Waterworks Operator Instructor before being promoted to
- Director of Compliance and Enforcement in 1999. In 2007, Melissa 16
- was named Deputy Director of Water Supply, and in 2012, Deputy 17
- Director of Environmental Health. In 2016, Melissa became 18
- Director of the Office of Licensure and six years later the Office 19

- 20 of Health Protection Director, a position she held until assuming
- 21 her present position as Assistant Senior Deputy in 2024; and
- 22 WHEREAS, in her various Department of Health roles, Melissa
- 23 served in many leadership positions of state emergency response
- 24 operations directly impacting assistance to thousands of
- 25 Mississippians, including the recoveries from Hurricane Katrina,
- 26 the April 28, 2014, Louisville EF-4 tornado, the Coronavirus
- 27 pandemic, and the March 24, 2023, Rolling Fork-Silver City EF-4
- 28 and Amory EF-3 tornadoes; and
- 29 WHEREAS, Melissa's legacy of work to protect and promote the
- 30 health of all Mississippians on behalf of the Department of Health
- 31 has been exemplified by sound judgement, firm leadership,
- 32 steadfast impartiality, consummate work ethic and superlative
- 33 customer service, and she has given this most important state
- 34 agency a statewide reputation for credibility and respect; and
- 35 WHEREAS, a native of Tupelo, Mississippi, a 1985 graduate of
- 36 Tupelo High School, a 1990 graduate of the University of
- 37 Mississippi, with a Bachelor's Degree in Biology, and a member of
- 38 Phi Mu Sorority, Melissa is married to Tony Parker of Morton,
- 39 Mississippi. They have two sons, Will and Charlie, and a
- 40 daughter-in-law, Neely; and
- 41 WHEREAS, we are grateful for Melissa's legacy of service in
- 42 state government and its impact on past, current and future
- 43 generations of Mississippians:
