## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 106

1 A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND CONGRATULATING THE COACHES FROM  
2 ACROSS MISSISSIPPI WHO HAVE BEEN CHOSEN FOR THE "TOMORROW'S 25  
3 COACHING FELLOWSHIP" PROGRAM.

4 WHEREAS, the "Tomorrow's 25 Coaching Fellowship" Program is  
5 presented by the Mississippi Association of Coaches (MAC), the  
6 Mississippi High School Activities Association (MHSAA), and the  
7 University of Mississippi's School of Education (UM SOE); and

8 WHEREAS, the "Tomorrow's 25 Coaching Fellowship" seeks to  
9 annually select and invest in 25 future leaders for Mississippi in  
10 the area of high school and middle school athletics; and

11 WHEREAS, the following candidates were chosen for the

31 WHEREAS, all 25 candidates were identified by a selection  
32 committee of peers, and represent the best the state has to offer  
33 based off their competency, character, and commitment to their  
34 school and community; and

35 WHEREAS, the "Tomorrow's 25 Coaching Fellowship" seeks to  
36 assist in three areas of growth for each candidate: Coaching the  
37 Whole Athlete (Leadership, Resilience, Empathy, and  
38 Responsibility), the opportunity to network with 24 of their peers  
39 who have demonstrated the capacity to be our state's future  
40 leaders in athletics, and access to current leaders in the  
41 Associations (MAC, MHSAA) and College Athletics to learn how they  
42 can grow their spheres of influence in their communities and  
43 across the state; and



44 WHEREAS, the ultimate goal of the "Tomorrow's 25 Coaching  
45 Fellowship" is for the selected candidates to have this time to  
46 deliberately work on their craft in a cohort of their peers, so  
47 that ultimately their student-athletes and overall communities  
48 benefit for years to come:

50 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby recognize and congratulate the  
51 coaches from across Mississippi who have been chosen for the
