SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 131

- A RESOLUTION CALLING UPON MISSISSIPPI LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT ENTITIES TO ENTER INTO 287(g) AGREEMENTS RELATING TO IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT.
- WHEREAS, President Donald J. Trump noted in Executive Order
- 5 14159, "Protecting the American People Against Invasion":
- 6 "Over the last 4 years, the prior administration invited,
- 7 administered, and oversaw an unprecedented flood of illegal
- 8 immigration into the United States. Millions of illegal aliens
- 9 crossed our borders or were permitted to fly directly into the
- 10 United States on commercial flights and allowed to settle in
- 11 American communities, in violation of longstanding Federal laws.
- 12 Many of these aliens unlawfully within the United States present
- 13 significant threats to national security and public safety,
- 14 committing vile and heinous acts against innocent Americans.
- 15 Others are engaged in hostile activities, including espionage,
- 16 economic espionage, and preparations for terror-related
- 17 activities. Many have abused the generosity of the American

- 18 people, and their presence in the United States has cost taxpayers
- 19 billions of dollars at the Federal, State, and local levels.
- 20 Enforcing our Nation's immigration laws is critically important to
- 21 the national security and public safety of the United States"; and
- 22 WHEREAS, the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant
- 23 Responsibility Act of 1996 added Section 287(g) to the Immigration
- 24 and Nationality Act (INA) authorizing U.S. Immigration and
- 25 Customs Enforcement (ICE) to delegate to state and local law
- 26 enforcement officers the authority to perform specified
- 27 immigration officer functions under the agency's direction and
- 28 oversight; and
- 29 WHEREAS, the 287(g) Program enhances the safety and security
- 30 of our nation's communities by allowing ICE Enforcement and
- 31 Removal Operations (ERO) to partner with state and local law
- 32 enforcement agencies to identify and remove criminal aliens; and
- 33 WHEREAS, the 287(g) Program allows ICE through the
- 34 delegation of specified immigration officer duties to enhance
- 35 collaboration with state and local law enforcement partners to
- 36 protect American residents through the arrest and removal of
- 37 aliens who undermine the safety of our nation's communities and
- 38 the integrity of U.S. immigration laws; and
- 39 WHEREAS, specifically, ICE Enforcement and Removal Operations
- 40 operates three 287(g) models:
- 41 (1) The Jail Enforcement Model, which is designed to
- 42 identify and process removable aliens with criminal or pending

- 45 (2) The Task Force Model, which serves as a force
- 46 multiplier for law enforcement agencies to enforce limited
- 47 immigration authority with ICE oversight during their routine
- 48 police duties.
- 49 (3) The Warrant Service Officer Program, which allows
- 50 ICE to train, certify and authorize state and local law
- 51 enforcement officers to serve and execute administrative warrants
- 52 on aliens in their agency's jail; and
- 53 WHEREAS, Executive Order 14159 requires ICE to authorize
- 54 State and local law enforcement officials, as the Secretary of
- 55 Homeland Security determines are qualified and appropriate, under
- 56 Section 287(q) of the Immigration and Nationality Act to "perform
- 57 the functions of immigration officers in relation to the
- 58 investigation, apprehension, or detention of aliens in the United
- 59 States under the direction and the supervision of the Secretary of
- 60 Homeland Security"; and
- 61 WHEREAS, countering the grave threat posed by the illegal
- 62 immigration crisis requires that local law enforcement agencies
- 63 cooperate with the federal government in the enforcement of
- 64 immigration law.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the
- 66 Mississippi Senate, that the Senate calls upon all of
- 67 Mississippi's local law enforcement entities to enter into 287(q)

- 68 agreements with ICE to protect our communities against the threat
- 69 posed by illegal, criminal aliens.
- 70 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate is
- 71 hereby authorized and directed to transmit a copy of this
- 72 resolution to all local law enforcement entities in the State of
- 73 Mississippi and make available to the Capitol Press Corps.
