- 27 to all those seeking help, assistance and services, key board
- 28 members and partners of Boots to Beyond work to identify
- 29 appropriate and meaningful free training opportunities, and the
- 30 organization holds "After Action" meetings following sponsored
- 31 events to evaluate its activities in order to ensure quality
- 32 control and efficiency and to identify any weaknesses in
