- 295 The State Auditor shall establish by regulation (12)procedures for refunds of state assessments, including refunds 296 297 associated with assessments imposed before July 1, 1990, and 298 refunds after appeals in which the defendant's conviction is 299 reversed. The Auditor shall provide in the regulations for 300 certification of eligibility for refunds and may require the 301 defendant seeking a refund to submit a verified copy of a court 302 order or abstract by which the defendant is entitled to a refund. 303 All refunds of state assessments shall be made in accordance with 304 the procedures established by the Auditor.
- 305 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 306 and after July 1, 2025.
