House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2526

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-103-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 37-103-25. (1) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions
- 8 of Higher Learning and the boards of trustees of the community
- 9 colleges and junior colleges are authorized to prescribe the
- 10 amount of tuition and fees to be paid by students attending the
- 11 several state-supported institutions of higher learning and
- 12 community colleges and junior colleges of the State of
- 13 Mississippi.
- 14 (2) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection and
- 15 subsections (3) and (4) of this section, the total tuition to be
- 16 paid by residents of other states shall not be less than the
- 17 average cost per student from appropriated funds. However, the
- 18 tuition to be paid by a resident of another state shall be equal
- 19 to the tuition amount established under subsection (1) of this
- 20 section if:

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               (a) * * * The nonresident is a "covered individual"
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    under Section 702 of the Veterans Access, Choice and
    Accountability Act of 2014. A nonresident veteran, as defined by
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    Title 38 of the United States Code or a person entitled to
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    education benefits under Title 38 of the United States Code who is
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    not a covered individual under Section 702 of the Veterans Access,
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    Choice and Accountability Act of 2014, but qualifies for Yellow
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    Ribbon Program funds shall be charged nonresident tuition provided
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    the state institution of higher learning and community or junior
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    college participates in the Yellow Ribbon Program and provides a
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    scholarship (including Yellow Ribbon Program funds) that results
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    in the nonresident veteran or person entitled to education
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    benefits under Title 38 paying tuition equal to the amount
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    established under subsection (1) of this section. All other
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    nonresident veterans, as defined by Title 38 of the United States
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    Code and other persons entitled to education benefits under Title
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    38, except those enrolled in a professional school or college,
    shall be charged tuition equal to the amount established under
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    subsection (1) of this section. This paragraph (a) shall be
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    administered and interpreted in the manner necessary to obtain or
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    retain approval of courses of education by the Secretary of the
    United States Department of Veterans Affairs and in a manner
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    necessary to allow a nonresident veteran or a person entitled to
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    education benefits under Title 38 of the United States Code and
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    state institutions of higher learning and community and junior
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46 colleges to fully participate and receive Yellow Ribbon Program

47 funds;

- 48 (b) The nonresident student is an evacuee of an area
- 49 affected by Hurricane Katrina or Hurricane Rita. This waiver
- shall be applicable to the 2005-2006 school year only * * *; and
- 51 (c) The nonresident student's out-of-state tuition was
- 52 waived according to subsection (3) or (4) of this section.
- 53 (3) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher
- 54 Learning may, in its discretion, consider and grant requests to
- 55 approve institution specific policies permitting the waiver of
- 56 out-of-state tuition when such an official request is made by the
- 57 president or chancellor of the institution and when such request
- 58 is determined by the board to be fiscally responsible and in
- 59 accordance with the educational mission of the requesting
- 60 institution.
- 61 (4) The board of trustees of any community college or junior
- 62 college may develop and implement a policy for waiving
- 63 out-of-state tuition for the college if the policy is determined
- 64 by the board to be in accordance with the educational mission of
- 65 the college and if a local industry or business or a state agency
- 66 agrees to reimburse the college for the entire amount of the
- 67 out-of-state tuition that will be waived under the policy. State
- 68 funds shall be allocated and spent only on students who reside
- 69 within the State of Mississippi. However, associate degree
- 70 nursing students who reside outside the State of Mississippi may
- 71 be counted for pay purposes.

72 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 73 and after July 1, 2025.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-103-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW NONRESIDENT STUDENTS TO FULLY PARTICIPATE IN THE YELLOW RIBBON PROGRAM AND RECEIVE FUNDS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
