House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3027

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. That the following sum, or so much thereof as may 6 be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State 7 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of 8 Veterinary Examiners for the purpose of defraying the expenses 9 incurred by said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, 10 and ending June 30, 2026......\$ 208,205.00.

SECTION 2. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Veterinary Examiners Board shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the S. B. 3027 PAGE 1 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
22 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
23 2025. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
24 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2027 shall be submitted to
25 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
26 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
27 during the Fiscal Year 2026 budget request process.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 28 29 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 30 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 31 32 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 33 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 34 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 35 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 36 37 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 38 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 39 40 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 41 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 42 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 43 and after July 1, 2025.
