

House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3054

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

23 **SECTION 1.** In addition to all other sums herein
24 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
25 necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
26 General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
27 Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Mississippi
28 Department of Health for the period upon passage, and ending June
29 30, 2026.....\$ 4,000,000.00.

30 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of matching
31 federal funds at the Local Governments and Rural Water Systems
32 Improvements Board.

33 **SECTION 2.** In addition to all other sums herein
34 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
35 necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
36 General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
37 Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Mississippi
38 Department of Archives and History for the period upon passage,
39 and ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 146,108.00.

40 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
41 operational expenditures.

42 **SECTION 3.** In addition to all other sums herein
43 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
44 necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
45 General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
46 Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Grand Gulf
47 Military Monument Commission for the period upon passage, and
48 ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 12,176.00.

49 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
50 operational expenditures.

51 **SECTION 4.** In addition to all other sums herein
52 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
53 necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
54 General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
55 Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Mississippi
56 Department of Environmental Quality for the period upon passage,
57 and ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 3,388,286.00.

58 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of matching
59 federal funds for the Clean Water Grant.

60 **SECTION 5.** In addition to all other sums herein
61 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
62 necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
63 General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
64 Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Mississippi

65 Department of Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks for the period upon
66 passage, and ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 1,941,952.00.

67 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of funding
68 the career ladder and rank classifications for all Law Enforcement
69 positions. No funds shall be used for escalations or increases in
70 the Lt. Colonel or Colonel classification ranks.

71 **SECTION 6.** In addition to all other sums herein
72 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
73 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
74 to the credit of the Mississippi Department of Wildlife,
75 Fisheries, and Parks and allocated in a manner as determined by
76 the Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Mississippi
77 Department of Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks for the period
78 beginning upon passage, and ending June 30, 2026.....
79\$ 1,373,578.00.

80 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of
81 recruiting, equipping, and training qualified law enforcement
82 cadets.

83 **SECTION 7.** In addition to all other sums herein
84 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
85 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
86 to the credit of the Office of Capital Post Conviction Counsel and
87 allocated in a manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, to
88 defray the expenses of the Office of Capital Post Conviction
89 Counsel for the period beginning upon passage, and ending June 30,
90 2026.....\$ 215,000.00.

91 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
92 operational expenses.

93 **SECTION 8.** In addition to all other sums herein
94 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
95 necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
96 General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
97 Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Mississippi
98 Office of the Attorney General for the period upon passage, and
99 ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 500,000.00.

100 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of providing
101 funding to a nationally recognized non-profit organization with a
102 proven track record of serving as a partner with Local Educational
103 Agencies (LEAs) by providing students in grades 6-12 with
104 financial literacy and workforce readiness curriculum and
105 programming in support of Mississippi schools. This curriculum may
106 be taught by volunteer teachers as described under Section
107 37-7-301 (rr).

108 **SECTION 9.** In addition to all other sums herein
109 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
110 necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
111 General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
112 Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the State Fire
113 Academy for the period upon passage, and ending June 30, 2026.....
114\$ 180,879.00.

115 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
116 operational expenses.

SECTION 10. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Mississippi Department of Human Services for the period upon passage, and ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 1,750,000.00.

This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying operational expenditures.

SECTION 11. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services for the period upon passage, and ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 1,649,833.00.

This additional appropriation is for the purpose of providing increases for Personal Care Attendants and for providing matching funds for federal grants.

SECTION 12. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services and allocated in a manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Mississippi

Department of Rehabilitation Services for the period beginning
upon passage, and ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 5,685,416.00.

This additional appropriation is for the purpose of providing
increases for Personal Care Attendants and for providing
additional operational expenditures associated with federal grant
programs.

SECTION 13. In addition to all other sums herein
appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
to the credit of the Soil and Water Conservation Commission and
allocated in a manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, to
defray the expenses of the Soil and Water Conservation Commission
for the period beginning upon passage, and ending June 30, 2026...
.....\$ 6,780,014.00.

This additional appropriation is for the purpose of providing
funding for planning, design, and construction services associated
with federal grant agreements.

SECTION 14. In addition to all other sums herein
appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
to the credit of the Supreme Court Continuing Legal Education and
allocated in a manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, to
defray the expenses of the Supreme Court Continuing Legal
Education for the period beginning upon passage, and ending June
30, 2026.....\$ 68,650.00.

167 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
168 operational expenses of the Continuing Legal Education Program.

169 **SECTION 15.** In addition to all other sums herein
170 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
171 necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
172 General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
173 Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Department of
174 Corrections for the period beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June
175 30, 2025.....\$ 4,314,425.00.

176 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
177 expenses of the medical program.

178 **SECTION 16.** In addition to all other sums herein
179 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
180 necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
181 General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
182 Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Department of
183 Child Protection Services for the period beginning upon passage,
184 and ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 4,497,176.00.

185 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
186 out-of-state therapeutic placement expenditures.

187 **SECTION 17.** In addition to all other sums herein
188 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
189 necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
190 General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
191 Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Department of

Child Protection Services for the period beginning upon passage,
and ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 3,339,144.00.

This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
salary and operational expenditures due to the increased number of
children in custody and in-home cases.

SECTION 18. In addition to all other sums herein
appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Department of
Child Protection Services for the period beginning upon passage,
and ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 3,988,367.00.

This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
temporary placement expenditures.

SECTION 19. In addition to all other sums herein
appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
General Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the
Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Joint
Legislative Code Committee for the period beginning July 1, 2024,
and ending June 30, 2025.....\$ 4,271.00.

This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
operational expenses.

SECTION 20. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after its passage.

9 2025 AND FISCAL YEAR 2026; THE OFFICE OF CAPITAL POST CONVICTION
10 COUNSEL FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025 AND FISCAL YEAR 2026; THE OFFICE OF
11 THE ATTORNEY GENERAL FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025 AND FISCAL YEAR 2026;
12 THE MISSISSIPPI FIRE ACADEMY FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025 AND FISCAL YEAR
13 2026; THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES FOR FISCAL
14 YEARS 2025 AND FISCAL YEAR 2026; THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF
15 REHABILITATION SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025 AND FISCAL YEAR
16 2026; THE SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION FOR FISCAL YEARS
17 2025 AND FISCAL YEAR 2026; THE OFFICE OF SUPREME COURT SERVICES
18 FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025 AND FISCAL YEAR 2026; THE DEPARTMENT OF
19 CORRECTIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILD
20 PROTECTIVE SERVICES FOR YEAR 2025; THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE CODE
21 COMMITTEE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
